## Morning Routine

## Hat

Sunshine North Primary School is a SunSmart school. In Term 1 and 4, students are required to wear a hat (broad-brimmed or bucket hat) to be able to play outside. We all know that NO HAT, NO PLAY, NO FUN FOR YOU TODAY! Students without a hat will be asked to stay at a shaded bench during lunch and recess.

## School Library

Once a week, students visit the school library to borrow books to take home. Please make sure your child returns their books so they can borrow new ones each week. If a student has lost a book, the cost of replacement is \$10.

## Classroom Library

Our Classroom Libraries are created with the help of your child! They are a place for students to explore a range of books and develop a love for reading.



If a student is **not** following these expectations, there are consequences:

- A verbal warning is given to the student.
- The student writes their name on the board as a second warning.
- If the behaviour continues, a cross will be put next to their name and they receive **5 minutes of time out**.
- If it persists, another cross will be put next to their name and they receive **10 minutes of time out** in another classroom.
- If it continues, the student will be referred to the principal and possibly parental involvement.



If a student **is** following these expectations, there are rewards:

- Merit & School Value awards
- Stickers
- You Have Been Caught Being Good
- Class rewards

Ticks and Wishes. When a student has obtained 10 ticks (or a certain amount of DojoPoints), they are given a WISH! This is a 30 minute pass to participate in an activity of their choice.



## Behaviour

Students participated in creating rules and expectations in their class.

## Tips to help your child read at home

Help them sound out unknown words.

Read a sentence and have your child read it after you.

Encourage your child to look at the pictures. Talk to them about what they can see.

Take turns reading a sentence or a page.

Talk about the book after reading.

Read and re-read the same books. Repeated reading helps build fluency!

## Home Reading

Students will take 10 books home to read every week. Students may borrow up to 2 choice books from the Library. Please make sure the 10 take home books are returned on Monday for your child to borrow another set of books for the week.

## RAZ-Kids

This is an electronic library for students to access for free. Your child will have a copy of their login details in their Home Practice book. This is their personal account - keep it safe!

## Mathletics

At Sunshine North we have a subscription to Mathletics. This is a mathematics program where students can practice skills they have learnt in the classroom. Your child will have a copy of their login details in their Home Practice book.
