PREVENTATIVE Pre-Correction

REMIND

the student what
they should be doing

REDIRECT

the focus on the
expected behaviour

RETEACH

the expected
behaviour when
student is calm

CHOICE/RESET

student is given a choice
to return to learning or
take a reset.

DOCUMENT

on Xuno if student
chooses a reset

Instructional Responses to Behaviour Errors

ASSESS SAFETY

Ensure the safety of all
individuals involved.

DE-ESCALATE

Use calming strategies to reduce
tension and prevent further
escalation of the situation.

RETEACH

Only when student is regulated.
Explain what the expectation is
relating to the incident.

CONSEQUENCE

Student is given a purposeful and
appropriate consequence that
involves understanding their actions
and the expected behaviour.

RESTORE

Repair relationships and support
re-entry to learning

DOCUMENT

on Xuno under major incident
